## Code of Conduct

Our Code of Conduct outlines what we expect from pupils and parents/carers when learning at home. This reflects our expectations of pupils when they are physically in school and is designed to help pupils get the most out of online learning.

Please read the following carefully:

Parents/carers	
	I will keep track of online sessions and learning.
	I will be present to oversee live lessons.
	I will keep my child's login details for online learning safe and will not share them with anyone.
	I will not take photos or record videos of my child's screen during live lessons.

Pupils	
	I will attend all live lessons on my timetable.
	I will only use the programmes my teacher tells me to use.



	I will only upload materials that are to do with my learning.
	I will not take photos or record videos of my screen during live lessons.
	I will be polite, kind and sensible when I am speaking or typing to others.

**When taking part in live lessons I will:**

	Be on time and have the right equipment for the lesson.
	Have my camera turned on with my microphone muted unless I am asked to speak.
	Use the 'raise hand' icon if I have a question and wait until the teacher asks me to unmute.
	Only include sensible comments in the chat function.
	Make sure I am wearing appropriate clothing.



	Be sat in a sensible place – for example, at a table or desk with no background noise.
	Be aware of what is visible in my background.
	Use appropriate language.
	Not disrupt anyone else's learning.
